**VILLAGE OF RUIDOSO

**A RESOLUTION
IN SUPPORT OF THE ALTO LAKES SPECIAL ZONING DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the required 51% of the resident voters of the area of the Alto Lakes Special Zoning District (ALSZD) did sign a petition requesting the formation of the Alto Lakes Special Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Lincoln did find that the petitioners have met all of the requirements for creation of the ALSZD as set forth in the Special Zoning District Act. NMSA 1978 Sec. 3-21-15 through 3-21-26; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Lincoln did affirm the creation of the ALSZD on July 8, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the ALSZD is intended to provide a community-based substitute for County Zoning, in the absence of that zoning in the County Lincoln; and

WHEREAS, portions, but not all, of the ALSZD may be inside the Ruidoso-Lincoln County Extraterritorial Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, it is useful and appropriate to establish and clarify a jurisdictional boundary

between the ALSZD and the said Extraterritorial Zone; and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of the ALSZD are established in the authorizing documents.

NOW THERE, BE IT RESOLVED:

THAT, the Alto Lakes Special Zoning District, under the administration of a properly established and elected Board of Commissioners, and in accordance with State Law, shall have jurisdiction over the area of the lawfully established Special Zoning District; and

THAT, such jurisdiction shall encompass all aspects of zoning authority within the ALSZD.

THAT, it is agreed and understood that this Resolution shall not be effective until such time as ALSZD has formally and legally adopted enforceable zoning laws and/or regulations.
