The following resolution amplifies specifics, in regard to ALSZD Ordinance, Section 5 – Definitions concerning Courtyard & Fenced Enclosures and fencing in general.

1. No wire fencing, such as chain-link, barbed wire, etc. is allowed.
2. Must be attached to the main structure at two places.
3. Support posts must match the structure, fencing is attached to. (i.e., stucco, wood, etc.)
4. Support post must be 6" X 6".
5. Post must be set in at least 18" of concrete.
6. Post must be vertical, in line with the structure it is attached to.
7. Any requested changes to ALSZD Ordinance guidelines, i.e. (fence post size, design, etc.), a Conditional Use Permit Application must be submitted.


All existing guidance within the ALSZD Ordinance, as it pertains to a. Dog Runs, b. Courtyards remains the same as published.


